Pool Hours of Operation 2023

While public school is in session May 27 through June 16, the hours of operation will be as follows:

- Monday, Memorial Day, May 29: 10 a.m. 8 p.m.
- Saturday and Sunday: 10 a.m. 8 p.m.
- Monday Friday: 2 p.m. 8 p.m.
 (except June 16, MCPS half day, 12 noon 9 p.m.)

After public school is out of session from Friday, June 16 through Saturday, August 26, the hours of operation will be as follows:

- June 16, Friday: 12 p.m. 9 p.m. (MCPS half day)
- Monday Friday 11 a.m. 9 p.m.
- Saturday: 10 am 8 p.m.
- Sunday: 10 a.m. 9 p.m.
- July 4, Tuesday: 10 a.m. 6 p.m. (Independence Day)

Sunday, August 27 through Monday, September 4, the hours of operation will be as follows:

- Sunday, August 27: 10 a.m. 8 p.m. (one hour shorter than previous Sundays)
- Monday Friday: 4 p.m. 8 p.m. (school in session)
- Saturday and Sunday: 10 a.m. 8 p.m.
- September 4, Labor Day: 10 a.m. 6 p.m.

New in 2023! Pool Breaks and Guest Passes

- Pool Breaks: To meet a Fair Housing Act requirement, the NMC Pool will no longer have an age discriminatory break every hour with all children ordered out of the water. Instead, a "Quiet Time" for 15 minutes will be instituted in which there will be NO balls, no games, no toys, and no jumping or diving in the pool allowed. Ice cream sales will be limited to this 15-minute period.
- Guest Passes and Fees: All NMC homeowners registered in MemberSplash will receive 10 guest passes (at no cost) for use during the 2023 season. But you MUST be registered in MemberSplash to receive the passes. Guest fees are \$2 per guest during the week and \$4 per guest on weekends and holidays.
